January 17, 2026 | Bolingbrook, IL | Attempted Bank Robbery – UPDATE: Woodridge Man Arrested

On January 16th at approximately 1:58 PM, Bolingbrook Police responded to the US Bank located at 443 N Bolingbrook Dr for a reported robbery. Upon arrival, officers learned the offender was no longer on scene but were able to obtain video surveillance of the offender and a photograph of the vehicle used to flee the scene.

Detectives from the Bolingbrook Police Department collaborated with the Federal Bureau of Investigation and quickly distributed the suspect’s information to patrol units. Shortly after 4:00 PM, patrol officers located the suspect’s vehicle parked and unoccupied in the 200 block of S Bolingbrook Dr. A short time later officers encountered Arthur Gage Jr. (44) of Woodridge walking on Fernwood Dr and took him into custody following a brief investigation.

Gage was charged with the following offenses related to his Fernwood Dr contact and transported to the Will County Adult Detention Facility.

- Armed Habitual Criminal
- Unlawful Use or Possession of a Weapon by a Felon
- Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapon
- Unlawful Possession of Firearms and Ammunition

The Bolingbrook Police Department is continuing to consult with the FBI reference their investigation into the Attempted Bank Robbery that occurred earlier in the day.
