**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6 OF THE BOLINGBROOK VILLAGE CODE
DECREASING CLASS "C-8" (BEER & WINE) FROM FIVE (5) TO FOUR (4) AND INCREASING
CLASS "D-2" (FULL-SERVICE) FROM SIXTEEN (16) TO SEVENTEEN (17) LOS COMALES
BOLINGBROOK LLC (278 S. WEBER RD)**

WHEREAS, Section 6(a) of Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois provides that any municipality which has a population of more than 25,000 is a home rule unit, and the Village of Bolingbrook, Will and DuPage Counties, Illinois, with a population in excess of 25,000 is, therefore, a home rule unit and, pursuant to the provisions of said Section 6(a) of Article VII, may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including, but not limited to, the power to tax and to incur debt.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BOLINGBROOK, WILL AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, IN THE EXERCISE OF ITS HOME RULE POWERS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: That Section 6-37(k) of Chapter 6 of the Bolingbrook Village Code is amended by decreasing the number of Class "C-8" licenses so that Section 6-37(k) shall hereafter be and read as follows:

Section 6-37. NUMBER OF LICENSES.

- (k) The total number of all Class "C-8" licenses issued and in force at any one time shall not exceed four (4) such licenses, unless and until the population of the Village shall reach 75,000 inhabitants. Thereafter, not more than one (1) additional Class "C-8" license shall be issued and in force at any time for each additional 4,500 inhabitants.

SECTION TWO: That Section 6-37(q) of Chapter 6 of the Bolingbrook Village Code is amended by increasing the number of Class "D-2" licenses so that Section 6-37(q) shall hereafter be and read as follows:

Section 6-37. NUMBER OF LICENSES.

- (q) The total number of all Class "D-2" licenses issued and in force at any one time shall not exceed seventeen (17) such licenses, unless and until the population of the Village shall reach 75,000 inhabitants. Thereafter, not more than one (1) additional Class "D-2" license shall be issued and in force at any time for each additional 4,500 inhabitants.

SECTION THREE: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effective immediately upon execution, from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
